Secondary cells and batteries - Marking symbols for identification of their chemistry

National foreword

This British Standard is the UK implementation of EN IEC 62902:2019. It is identical to IEC 62902:2019.

The UK participation in its preparation was entrusted to Technical Committee PEL/21, Secondary cells and batteries.

A list of organizations represented on this committee can be obtained on request to its secretary.

BSI, as a member of CENELEC, is obliged to publish EN IEC 62902:2019 as a British Standard. However, attention is drawn to the fact that during the development of this European Standard, the UK committee voted against its approval.

The UK committee's objection relates to the second paragraph of 5.3, which specifies that the background colour of the marking shall be different from the colour of the battery case. The colour of the background is specified in the first paragraph and could therefore be the same as the colour of the battery case. The UK committee proposed that black on white marking should be allowed.

This publication does not purport to include all the necessary provisions of a contract. Users are responsible for its correct application.

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Compliance with a British Standard cannot confer immunity from legal obligations.
