- present to the responsible international/European committee any enquiries on the interpretation, or proposals for change, and keep the UK interest informed;
- monitor related international and European developments and promulgate them in the UK.

The main differences between BS 3900-D1:1978 and this Part of BS 3900 are as follows:

- a) the standard is technically updated;
- b) a colour difference rating scheme is included.
