This British Standard is the English language version of EN ISO 4672:1999. It is identical with ISO 4672:1997. It supersedes BS EN 24672:1993, which is withdrawn.

The UK participation in its preparation was entrusted by Technical Committee PRI/66, Rubber and plastics tubing, hoses and hose assemblies, to Subcommittee PRI/66/4, Methods of test, which has the responsibility to:

- aid enquirers to understand the text;
- present to the responsible international/European committee any enquiries on the interpretation, or proposals for change, and keep the UK interests informed;

This British Standard incorporates changes to the wording describing the apparatus for the sub-ambient temperature stiffness test compared to the standard being superseded (BS EN 24672:1993).
