Soft solder alloys — Chemical compositions and forms (ISO 9453:2014)

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National foreword

This British Standard is the UK implementation of EN ISO 9453:2014. It supersedes BS EN ISO 9453:2006, which is withdrawn.

The Introduction explains that the holders of patent rights have declared to ISO that they are willing to negotiate licences either free of charge or under reasonable and non-discriminatory terms and conditions with applicants throughout the world. According to ISO’s rules, this is necessary if patented material is to be included in a standard. A list of those who are said to have done this is in Annex B.
