This British Standard is the UK implementation of ISO 18400-102:2017. It supersedes BS ISO 10381-2:2002 which is withdrawn. Together with BS ISO 18400-104, BS ISO 18400-105:2017 and BS ISO 18400-206 it supersedes BS ISO 10381-6:2009 which will be withdrawn upon publication of all remaining parts of the BS ISO 18400 series

BS ISO 18400-102:2017 is intended to be used in conjunction with BS 10175:2011+A1:2013 and other members of the BS ISO series of standards as appropriate. Where there are differences in the guidance given in this standard and that in BS 10175:2011+A1:2013, the guidance in this standard takes precedence. The UK committee notes that this standard covers a wide variety of situations in which investigations including sampling to determine soil quality might be carried out rather than being focused on potentially contaminated sites, as is the case in BS 10175:2011+A1:2013.

The UK participation in its preparation was entrusted to Technical Committee EH/4, Soil quality.
