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Foreword

ISO (the International Organization for Standardization) is a worldwide federation of national standards bodies (ISO member bodies). This third edition cancels and replaces the second edition (ISO 2115:1976), which has been extended and harmonized, taking account of the requirements of ISO/TC 35, *Paints and varnishes*.

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
