Foreword

ISO (the International Organization for Standardization) is a worldwide federation of national standards bodies (ISO member bodies). International Standard ISO 8442-1 was prepared by the European Committee for Standardization (CEN) in collaboration with ISO Technical Committee TC 186, *Cutlery and table and decorative metal hollow-ware*, in accordance with the Agreement on technical cooperation between ISO and CEN (Vienna Agreement).
